Dear Resident/Holiday maker,

The Mount Festival of Multisport is set to return to Mount Maunganui and surrounding suburbs in 2017. Where in previous years the MFOM has incorporated satellite events on the days leading up to, and after the Port of Tauranga Half; in 2017 the event has been condensed to focus on the keystone events and limit the impact on the local community.

We greatly appreciate your understanding, patience and support for this long standing community event and wish to make sure our impact on you over the event weekend is limited as possible.

#### Event Infrastructure & Road Closures

To allow for the event team to set up the transition and event village, and to ensure the safety of competitors and spectators during the event there will be a number of parking restrictions, road closures and road cautions in place over the event weekend which may impact on access to your property.

**No Parking Restrictions** will be put in force on The Mall and Adams Ave (between Prince Ave and Maunganui Road) from **4.30am on Saturday the 7<sup>th</sup> of January** – please ensure all vehicles are parked up driveways or on surrounding streets to prevent being towed.

#### Road Closures

##### Friday 6<sup>th</sup> January [6.00am – Saturday 10.00pm]

- Event Village set up and Transition installation in Pilot Bay & Salisbury Wharf Carpark
- The Mall (Salisbury Wharf to Prince Ave)

##### Saturday 7<sup>th</sup> January [4.30am till 6.00pm]

- The Mall – (Prince Ave to Adams Ave including Pilot Bay Boat Ramp)

Please take note of the times and roads as it is likely to affect your route and access. We urge you to plan ahead, take alternative routes and use caution when coming out of your driveway.

While we must maintain access to residents we can only do so when a Course Marshall or Event Official deems it safe to do so. There is a high chance you will be stopped and asked to wait until there is a safe opportunity, especially as there will be children involved. There is going to be a significant number of spectators and participants in Pilot Bay and the wider peninsula. We hugely appreciate your patience during this time and we will do all that we can to reduce the impact on access to your property.
